POLICY: PROCEDURES FOR NOMINATION AND ELECTION OF SECTION OFFICERS

Approved by the Section Board of Directors 21 August 2014

1. Section Officers. The Officers of the Central Section shall consist of a President, 1st Vice President, 2nd Vice President, Past President, Secretary-Treasurer (bonded), one (1) Council Delegate, and one (1) Alternate Council Delegate.
2. Composition and Election. Officers of the Section must be in good standing of the Section and IMSA International. Officers, other than the Council Delegate and Alternate Delegate, are elected by a majority of the Section Voting Members voting where a quorum is present; the Section Board of Directors sets forth the procedures for how candidates are nominated and elected.
3. The election of the President, 1st Vice President and 2nd Vice President, and confirmation of the Past President, shall occur in even-numbered years for a two (2) year term.
4. The election of the Council Delegate, Alternate Delegate and Secretary-Treasurer shall occur in odd-numbered years for a two (2) year term.
5. The Section Board of Directors shall appoint a Nominating Committee by September 1 of each year, charged with nominating a candidate or candidates for each office whose term expires the following year. A member of the Section Board of Directors, whose term is not expiring the following year, shall serve as the Chair of the Nominating Committee.
6. The Nominating Committee shall report a slate of candidates to the Section Board of Directors by November 1, together with a letter of acceptance from each nominee; at which time the Nominating Committee shall be disbanded.
7. The Section Board of Directors shall notify the Section Members of the Nominating Committee Report by November 15 and solicit additional nominees for each position.
8. Nominations from the membership shall be received by the Section Board of Directors by January 15, together with a letter of acceptance from the nominee.
9. If there is more than one (1) nominee for any position, an election shall be held during the Annual Business Meeting at the Section Annual Conference.
10. Any position that has only one (1) nominee shall be sustained by the membership during the Annual Business Meeting at the Section Annual Conference.
11. No more than two (2) positions may be held by individuals employed by the same organization.
